GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Performs routine maintenance of athletic fields and facilities, does related work as required. Work is performed under the immediate supervision of Maintenance Supervisor, Sports Complex Coordinator, Parks and Sports Field Manager, or a Recreation Maintenance Crew Leader.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

Participates in the maintenance and construction of parks and recreation buildings, athletic fields and facilities, and equipment associated thereof. Employee may supervise/work with jail trustees and community service workers in carrying out the duties of this position. Position is subject to pre-employment physical to include alcohol and drug screening and random alcohol and drug screening

EXAMPLES OF WORK *(Illustrative Only):*

- Maintenance of athletic fields, park facilities, and other County property for sports and general citizen use. Work includes mowing, trimming, laying out and marking fields for various sports, trash pickup, general cleaning of grounds, restrooms and concession stands.
- Maintenance or Supervision of indoor facilities for department sports leagues and general citizen use.
- Responsible for the care and maintenance of tools and equipment.
- Snow removal.
- May also assist Building Maintenance with projects as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

PHYSICAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS:

- Lifting and carrying up to 50 pounds;
- Climbing, balancing, stooping, sitting, standing, walking, crawling, and grasping;
- Speaking to express or exchange ideas and information;
- Hearing to perceive information at normal spoken levels as well as to detect the movement of people, machines and vehicles;
- Visual acuity is required for use of measuring devices, operation of machines, operation of motor vehicles or equipment, determining the accuracy or thoroughness of work and observing general surroundings and Toleration of

- inside and outside environmental conditions, extreme cold, extreme heat, noise, vibration, hazards, atmospheric conditions, oils, and uneven terrains and surfaces;
- Eye-hand coordination, dexterity and control to type, write, sketch, draw and to operate vehicles, equipment and tools.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Some knowledge related to park mowing and use of equipment
- Basic knowledge of sports and recreation programs
- Ability to use hand-held power tools
- Ability to follow simple oral and written directions
- Possession of a valid drivers license and a good driving record
- Ability to work efficiently and effectively to meet required deadlines
- Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, other County employees and the general public.

ACCEPTABLE EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Some experience in facilities and grounds maintenance
- Tool and equipment operation related to a parks and recreation program
- Completion of a standard high school diploma preferred
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training that provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities to successfully perform in this position
