

Utility Connection Fee Reduction/Waiver Policy

Persons applying for County water and/or sewer residential service connections and whose annual household income is within Low and Moderate Income Limits as defined by the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (available from the Roanoke-Alleghany Regional Commission), may apply for reduced or waived connection fees as follows:

<u>Income as a % of LMI Limit</u>	<u>% Fee Waiver</u>
Over 100	0
90 to 100	50
75 to 89	75
Below 75	100

Persons applying for reduced/waived connection fees must report their household size and total annual household income on a form approved by the County Administrator for the purpose. The applicant must provide a copy of the most recent Federal Income Tax Return Form 1040EZ, 1040A or 1040 for each wage earner within the applicant's household. If the applicant or other wage earners within his or her household did not file a federal income tax return for the most recent tax period, the applicant must provide a copy of the most recent year's W-2 and/or 1099 forms for all non-filing wage earners within his or her household. The applicant must certify the accuracy and completeness of the information provided. All tax forms will be returned to the applicant upon approval or denial of utility connection fee waiver.
