

Ten Apples Up On Top Activity

Supplies:

- 1 piece of white cardstock cut in half, to make two 4 ¼ x 11 inch pieces.
- Construction or printer paper in orange, black and red.
- 2 googly eyes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Marker

Instructions:

1. From the orange and black construction paper cut out the pieces to the tiger face.
 - 1 big orange circle (face)
 - 1 small circle, cut in half (ears)
 - 4 small triangles (stripes)
 - 1 small circle (nose)Cut out the 10 apples from the red paper.
2. Glue the card stock together on the short edges to make a long rectangle.
3. Glue the orange circle at the bottom of the cardstock rectangle.
4. Then glue on the ears, the stripes on the side of the face and the eyes.
5. Use the marker to draw a smile.
6. Ask your child to choose the number 1 apple and count as they put the apple on the tiger's head. Continue with 2-10. Remove the apples and have them put the apples on beginning with number 10, counting backwards to number 1.
