Airplane Piggy Bank

Supplies:

- Plastic bottle, washed, dried, and label removed.
- Printer paper
- Cardstock or construction paper, various colors
- Scissors
- Double sided tape or glue

Instructions:

- 1. Print the plane's body template. Fold the printer paper in half, short sides together. Keep the paper folded and cut on the black lines.
- 2. Wrap the body piece around the bottle. Glue the tail sections together, then glue or tape the rest of paper together where the two ends overlap.
- 3. From the construction paper cut two 2x5 inch rectangles. Glue the short ends of a rectangle together to form a tube. Repeat with the other rectangle. Glue or tape them to the sides of the bottle. These will be the airplane's engines.
- 4. Cut out the wings. Glue the larger wings over the engines and the smaller wings on the sides of the tail section.
- 5. Cut out circles from the construction paper and glue them along both sides of the bottle to make the planes windows.
- 6. Cut out the propeller and put it under the bottle cap.
- 7. Ask an adult to cut a rectangle, about an inch long, in the top of the airplane.
- 8. Start saving in your new bank!
